ADU virtual listening sessions

May 3 @ 5-6pm and May 11 @ 2-3pm

The City is examining ways to expand the use of Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) in Lafayette. Sometimes referred to as an in-law suite or carriage house, an ADU is a small independent living space on the same lot as a single-family home. The proposed regulations, if implemented, would give certain homeowners the option to construct an ADU on their property if they meet existing standards related to size, location, lot coverage, and other factors.

City staff is hosting listening sessions to better understand residents' interests and concerns about this project. The sessions will include a brief presentation and time for questions and comments. Learn more about the project and meeting details at lafayette-listens.com/ADUs.
